## Autumn School "Good Governance through Civil Society Engagement"

### October 19-23, 2015 in Lviv

European College of University of Tartu and Faculty of International Relations of Ivan Franko National University of Lviv are jointly organizing an Autumn School "Good Governance through Civil Society Engagement" in Lviv, Ukraine.

The aim for the Autumn School is to open a discussion about the concept of "good governance" and how it could be seen in the context of the contemporary Ukraine. During these five days, the recent developments of Estonia and Ukraine are under observation: What are the similarities and differences of these two countries? What are the fruits of the transition period for Estonia and Ukraine? How can Estonia be as an example for Ukraine? What could be the alternative examples? In addition, the Autumn School touches upon the different ways civil society contributes to the development of a country, for instance, private and social entrepreneurship, the cooperation between NGO-s and private sector, youth work and cultural activities. Lectures also involve a very practical side of e-governance and how it affects the transparency of governmental institutions. During the Autumn School participants will work in groups in order to compose an innovative project that will be presented on the last day of the event.

The Autumns School is open to Ukrainian students from different backgrounds, who have completed at least 2 years of university education and to young professionals holding a BA degree.

The language of instruction is English.

The Autumns School grants 6 ECTS.

Participation is free of charge.
